# MOBILE ROLLOUT: 55 IPHONES, 5 IPADS DEPLOYED

Client Support Services is making significant strides with the Mobile Rollout Program. The team has deployed 55 iPhones and 5 iPads to teams in Electric, Plumbing, Fire Maintenance, Building Mechanical, Access Control, Carpentry, Paint, Sheet Metal, and Irrigation. These devices are designed to streamline fieldwork and are equipped with 49 preloaded apps and tools, including FAMIS 360, R'Space, the EH&S Safe App, key contacts, and departmental forms.

In-person trainings, resource materials, and a dedicated <u>Mobile Support Site</u> have been introduced. Technicians will soon be able to request material parts through a new inventory module.

#### Filter Program Overhaul

The Butler Building's front layout is shaping up for FS's new filter program. This is the first step of the warehouse inventory program, managed by **Jeffrey Beal**, procurement and material inventory supervisor. By bringing filter installation in house, FS will reduce costs from \$750K to \$350K annually. Building maintenance workers and new staff will install the filters in air handlers for 75 campus buildings as part of preventative maintenance.
